FOR THOSE WISHING TO PUBLISH NSRI SOIL MAPS AND OTHER NSRI INFORMATION IN A PRINTED PUBLICATION OR DIGITAL PRODUCT

Introduction

The National Soil Resources Institute (NSRI), formerly Soil Survey and Land Research Centre, at Cranfield University has published a wide range of soil maps and reports covering areas of England and Wales. It also possesses a range of digital information. These publications and information sources are protected by the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988. A *Map and Information Publication Licence* is required if any part of a map, map legend, report or digital product is to be included in a publication or other product.

A *Map and Information Publication Licence* can be taken out by an individual or organisation by contacting the National Soil Resources Institute at the address below. If a map with Ordnance Survey topographic information is to be published, a further licence from the Ordnance Survey will be required.

Licensees wishing to copy and reproduce, but not publish, parts of maps, map legends or reports as part of their business must enter into a *Map and Information Reproduction Licence*. These are available from the same source.

Fees

A basic fee of £100 plus VAT is charged for each discrete item e.g. plate, figure, table of data and must be fully paid in advance of publication. If the same item is used in more than one publication or other product, a licence and fee is required for each separate publication or product. When an item is to be published in an academic journal as part of an authored paper, a licence is required but no fee will normally be payable.

Terms and Conditions
