Map and Information Reproduction Licences

FOR THOSE WISHING TO COPY NSRI SOIL MAPS AND OTHER NSRI INFORMATION FOR BUSINESS USE

Introduction

The National Soil Resources Institute (NSRI), formerly the Soil Survey and Land Research Centre, at Cranfield University has published a range of soil maps and reports covering areas of England and Wales. These publications are protected by the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988. You need a licence from Cranfield University, NSRI, if you wish, as part of your business, to:

- copy or reproduce, redraw, scan, digitise and store in an electronic medium, transmit electronically or read on a computer, project on a display screen or transform onto a different medium any part of a map, map legend or report the original of which is on paper or in electronic form. This includes internal business use within your office and the inclusion of parts of maps, map legends and/or reports within unpublished reports passed to any third party as part of your business.
- translate into a different language any part of a report.

The creation of any form of digital dataset with attached or embedded attributes from a map, map legend or report is specifically excluded from this form of licence and will require a *Cranfield University NSRI Data Licence*.

Those wishing to incorporate part of a map, map legend or report within a document or digital product that will be published must enter into a *Map and Information Publication Licence*. If part of a map with Ordnance Survey topographic information is to be reproduced, a further licence from OS will be required. For publication of part of a map, map legend or report on the world wide web, please contact NSRI at the address given below.

A *Map and Information Reproduction Licence* can be taken out by an individual or organisation:

Fees

The following options are available:

- **Small volume licence** (up to an annual cumulative total of 50 A4-sized copies of parts of individual soil maps, map legends and/or reports with an additional unit charge for extra copies)

Annual licence fee: £250 + VAT

Further copies over fifty: £2 + VAT per A4-sized copy

- **Large volume licence:** (unlimited copies of parts of individual soil maps, map legends and/or reports)

Annual licence fee: £950 + VAT

Small volume licences only apply to a specified single business address. Licensees wishing to copy and make use of soil maps, soil map legends and reports at more than one business address are obliged to enter into a large volume licence. Licence fees are due annually in advance.

Terms and Conditions

Every Map and Information Reproduction Licence is subject to terms and conditions. Licences will include a schedule specifying the details of the licence and any restrictions to the licensee's rights under the licence.
